Draw a face on each rectangle. Stick the rectangles onto the box. How many faces does a cuboid have? Count to find out</p>
<p>Wider Curriculum</p> 	<p>Wider Curricular Lesson:26 Clay Worms- Use clay (or available resources e.g. salt dough) to make a worm.</p> 	<p>Wider Curricular Lesson:27 Butterfly symmetry painting- Decorate one side of a butterfly with a pattern (see template). Fold the paper the other way so that the design prints on the other side. What do you notice?</p> 	<p>Wider Curricular Lesson: 28 Lady bird- Use coloured paper to make a ladybird (see template). Children to cut out shapes and stick together. Use pipe cleaners for antennae.</p> 	<p>Wider Curricular Lesson: 29 Paper plate snail- Use a paper plate to make a snail. Child to draw a spiral on the plate and cut it out. Decorate using finger painting.</p> 	<p>Wider Curricular Lesson: 30 Movement-Can you move like the different bugs? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=utWrlWq2_tk You could even dress up as one of the mini beasts.</p>
