#### How Can You Help?

Additional support staff will be allocated at these times to support mark making or lunch times, so please ensure your child arrives at school on time. Arriving on time will also prevent children from different bubbles from being in close proximity to each other.
- Please label any items of clothing such as jumpers, coats etc. to avoid losing them, please ask a member of staff if you would like us to do this for you with a permanent marker.
- If you have pictures of your child with their family, celebrating special events or learning new things (riding a bike, baking a cake etc.) we would love to share them with the class. Please bring in a photograph for us to photocopy or email the photograph to the school office.
- Make and Bake – To contribute towards our weekly 'Make and Bake' cookery sessions, we ask parents for a donation of £1.50 each half term to help us buy our ingredients.

#### Other

##### **COVID-19**

In September we ask that you say goodbye to your child at the classroom door and social distance yourselves from other parents and children. This will enable all children to come into school safely. Please can we also ask that only one parent drops your child off.

If your child becomes unwell in school we will ask you to pick them up as soon as possible. If your child has COVID-19 symptoms they will need to have a test. If your child or any siblings show symptoms at home we ask that you do not send them to school until your child has been tested and the test has come back as negative.

Parents/carers will only be able to come into school by prior appointment, and only if we are not able to discuss the matter on the telephone. If you wish to speak to your child's class teacher or a member of the senior team, you will need to email the office and someone will get back to you.
