English

Your child will:

Genres;

- Study the features of and write in a range of genres, including, instruction, narrative, diary, poetry, autobiography and persuasive argument.

Grammar and punctuation;

- Use capital letters, full stops, commas, questions and exclamation marks accurately.
- Use the past and present tense correctly.
- Use apostrophes to mark contraction of a word e.g. don't as opposed to do not.
- Use verbs in 1st and 3rd person.
- Have daily spelling, guided reading and handwriting lessons.

Mathematics

Your child will:

Number and Place Value

- Count in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100; find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number.
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number (hundreds, tens, ones).
- Read and write, compare, order and represent numbers up to 1000.
- Solve number problems and practical problems involving these ideas.

Calculation (addition and subtraction)

- add and subtract numbers with up to three digits, mentally and using formal methods.
- Have daily fluency lessons where we will practice the recall of key number facts.
- Have 'Flashback' sessions where we will catch up with learning that was missed.
