Theme: Ancient Egypt
This half-term, our Year 4 theme is The Egyptians.

<p>English <i>The Egyptian Cinderella</i> Your child will:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop their ability to write a setting description, including the use of adjectives, prepositions, noun phrases and apostrophes for possession. • Develop their ability to write their own traditional tale, including the use of a wide range of punctuation. • Develop their ability to write a persuasive letter, including the use of adverbs, fronted adverbials and a focus on sentence structure. • Develop their ability to write a list poem, including the use of similes, metaphors and a range of adventurous adjectives. • Develop their ability to write a non-chronological report, including the use of conjunctions, nouns and pro nouns. • Develop their ability to write a balanced argument, including the use of subordinating clauses and the correct tense. • Have daily spelling, guided reading and handwriting lessons.
<p>Mathematics Your child will:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn about number and place value. They will work with numbers in the thousands, become familiar with Roman Numerals and begin to look at negative numbers. • Develop their knowledge of addition and subtraction up to thousands. • Have daily fluency lessons where we will focus on the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). These sessions will have particular emphasis on times tables. • Have 'Flashback Friday' sessions where children will catch up with missed learning from last year.
